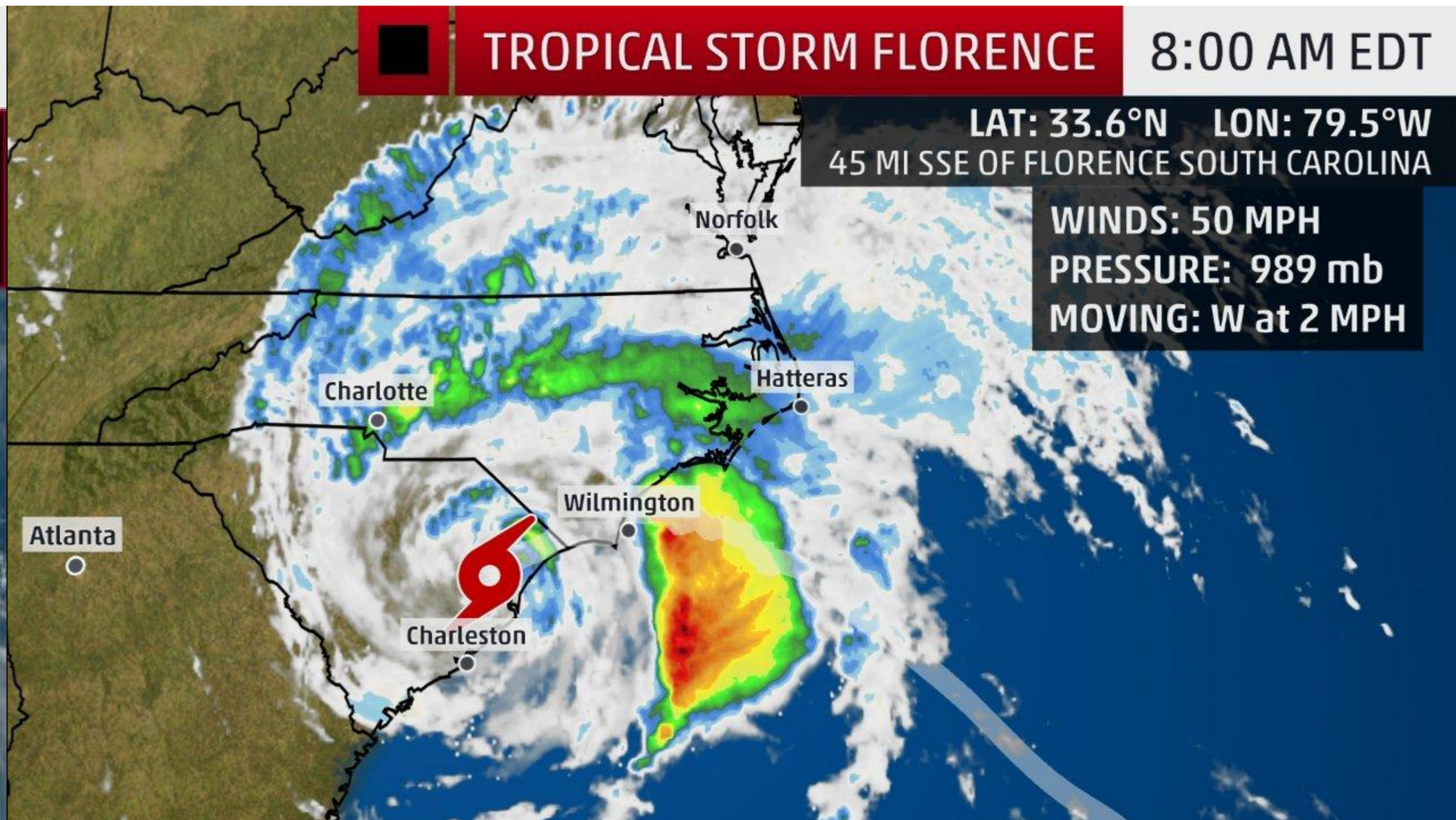

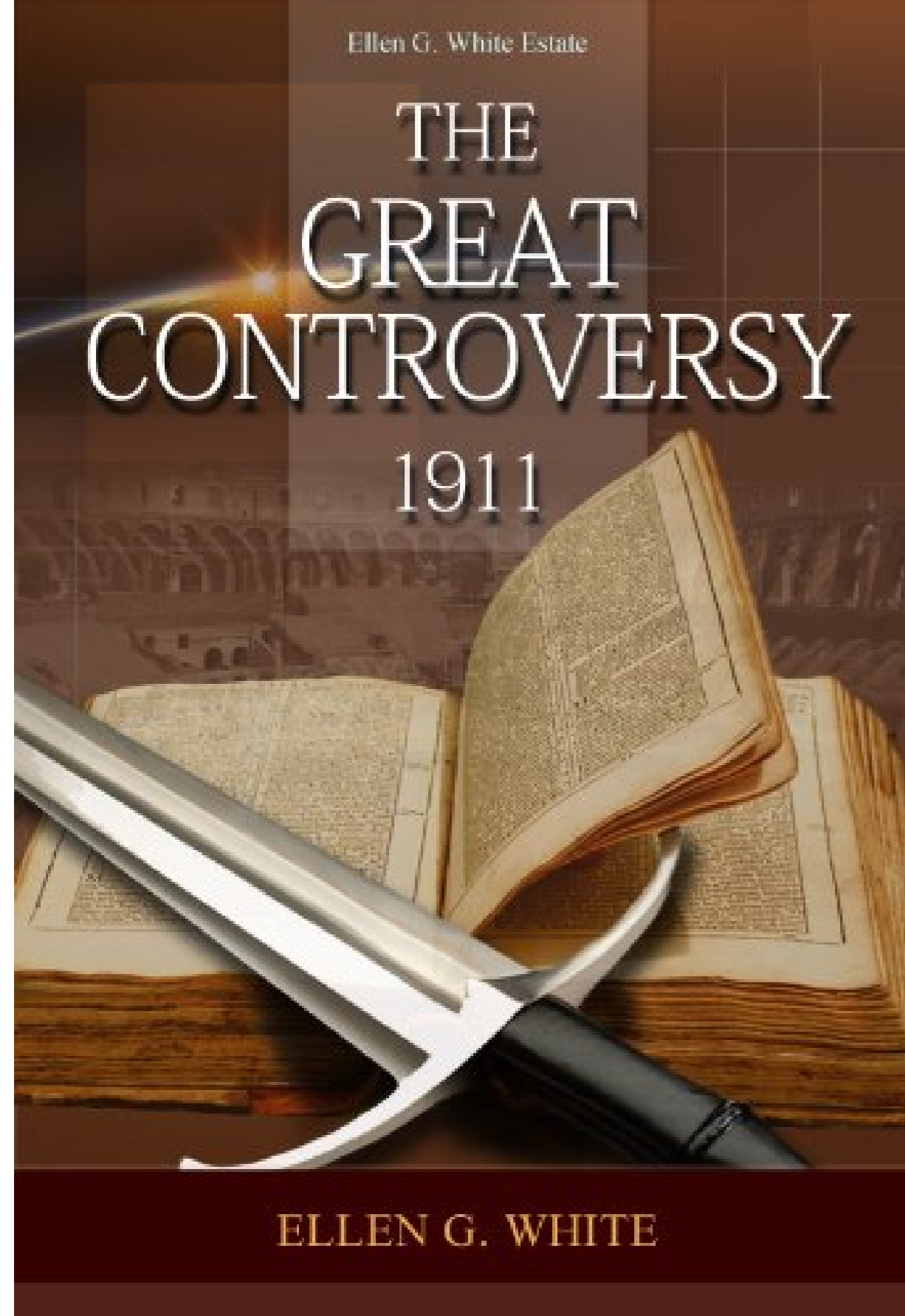

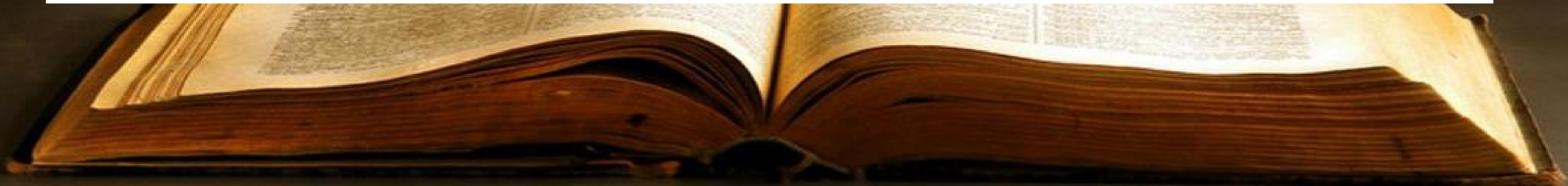

5 The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, **broken the everlasting covenant.**

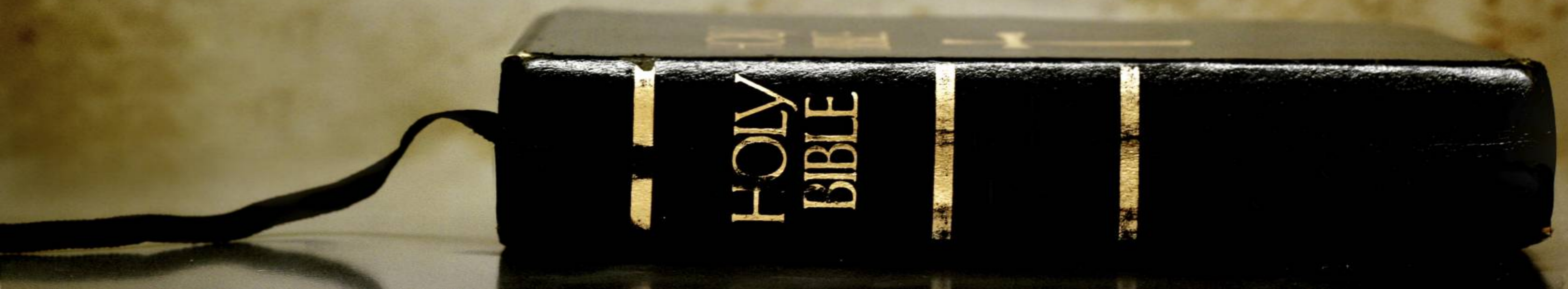

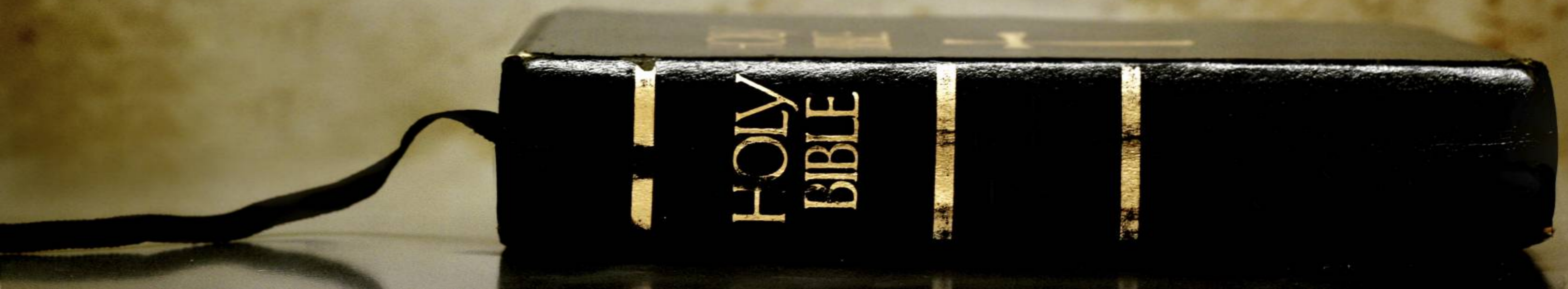


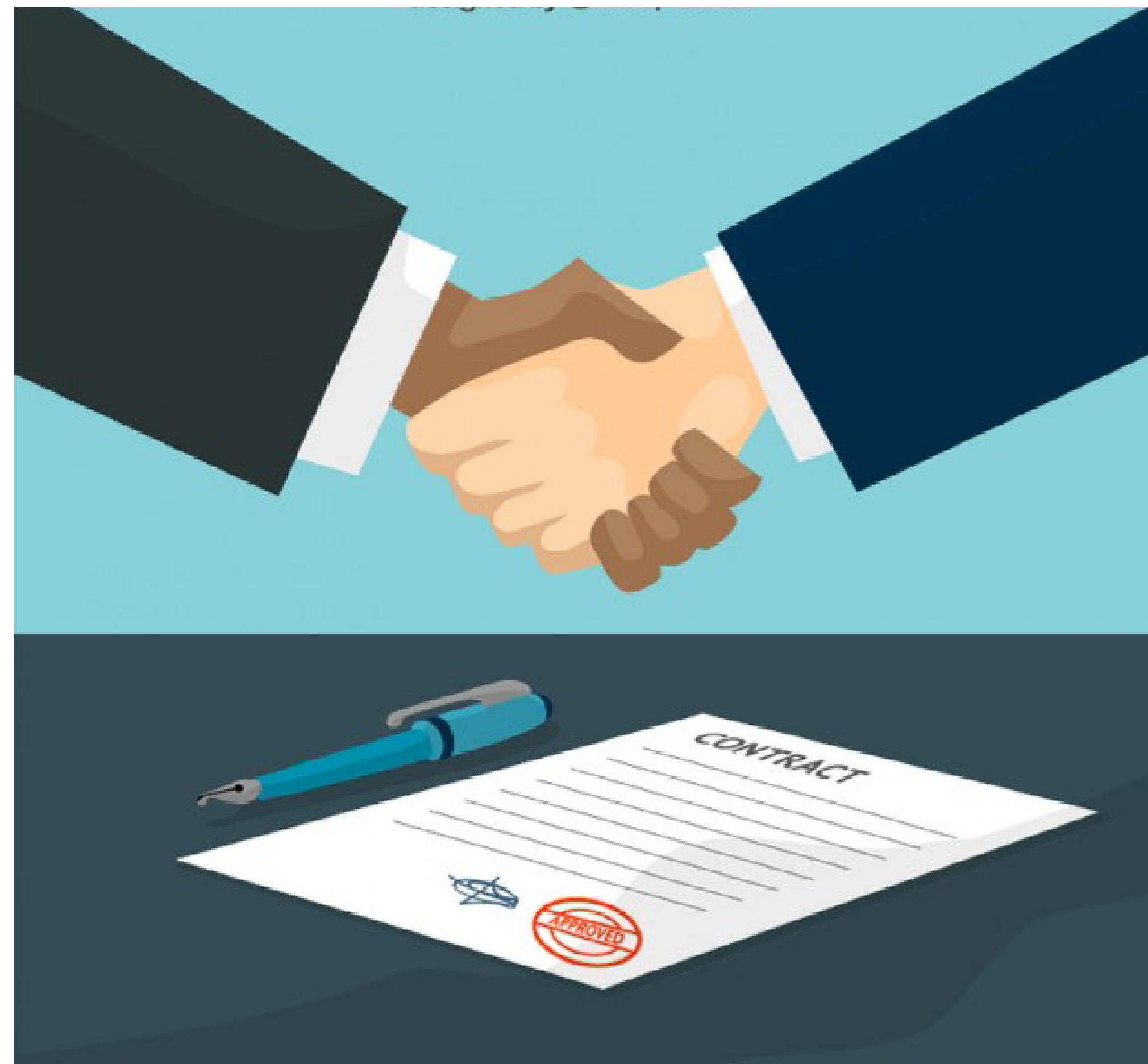
What is the everlasting covenant?



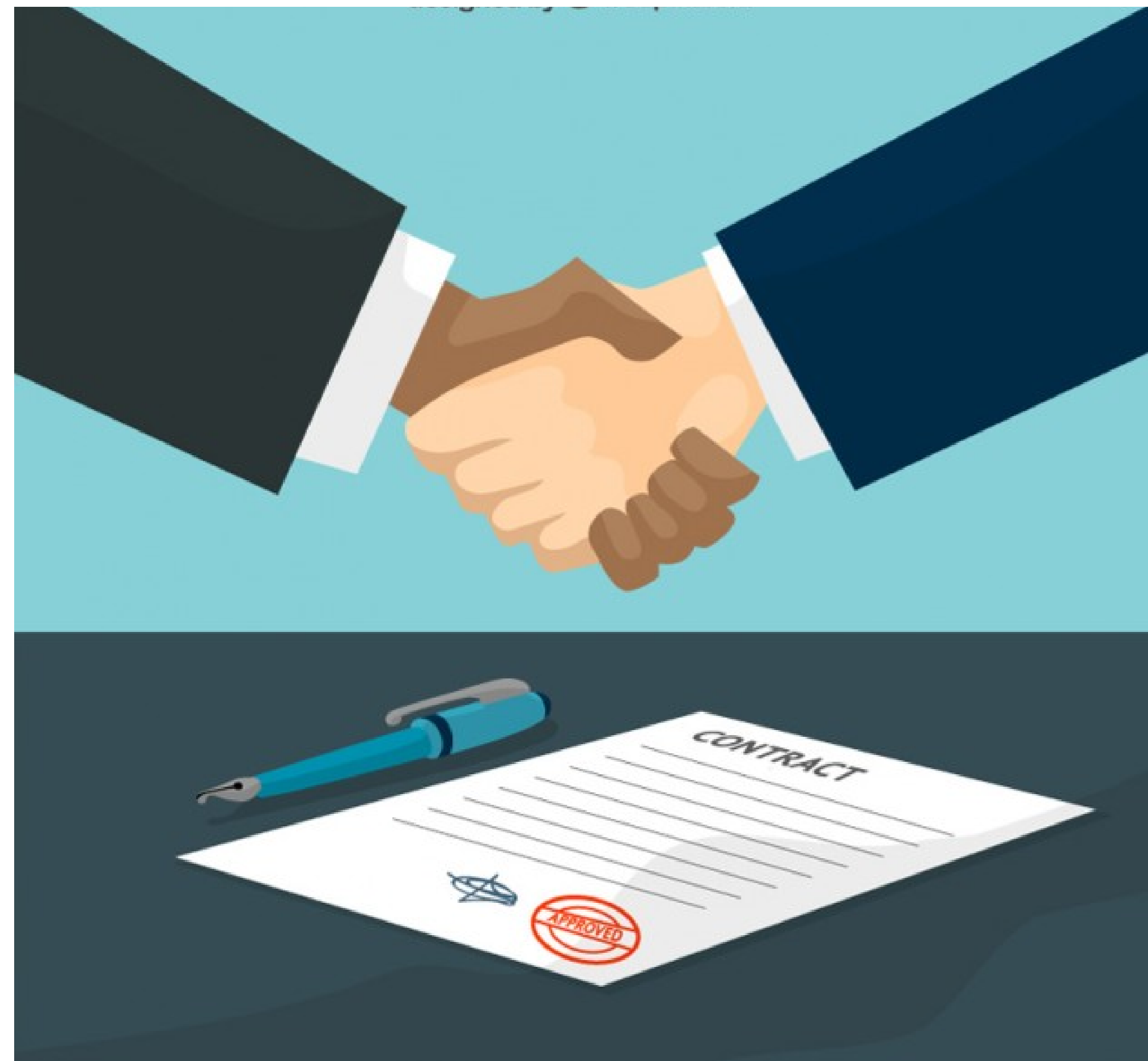
Covenant (Hebrew), berîyth [*ber-eeth'*] (*Strong's Reference #H1285*)

From H1262 (in the *sense of cutting* (like H1254)); a *compact* (because made by passing between *pieces of flesh*): - **confederacy, [con-]feder[-ate], covenant, **league**.**

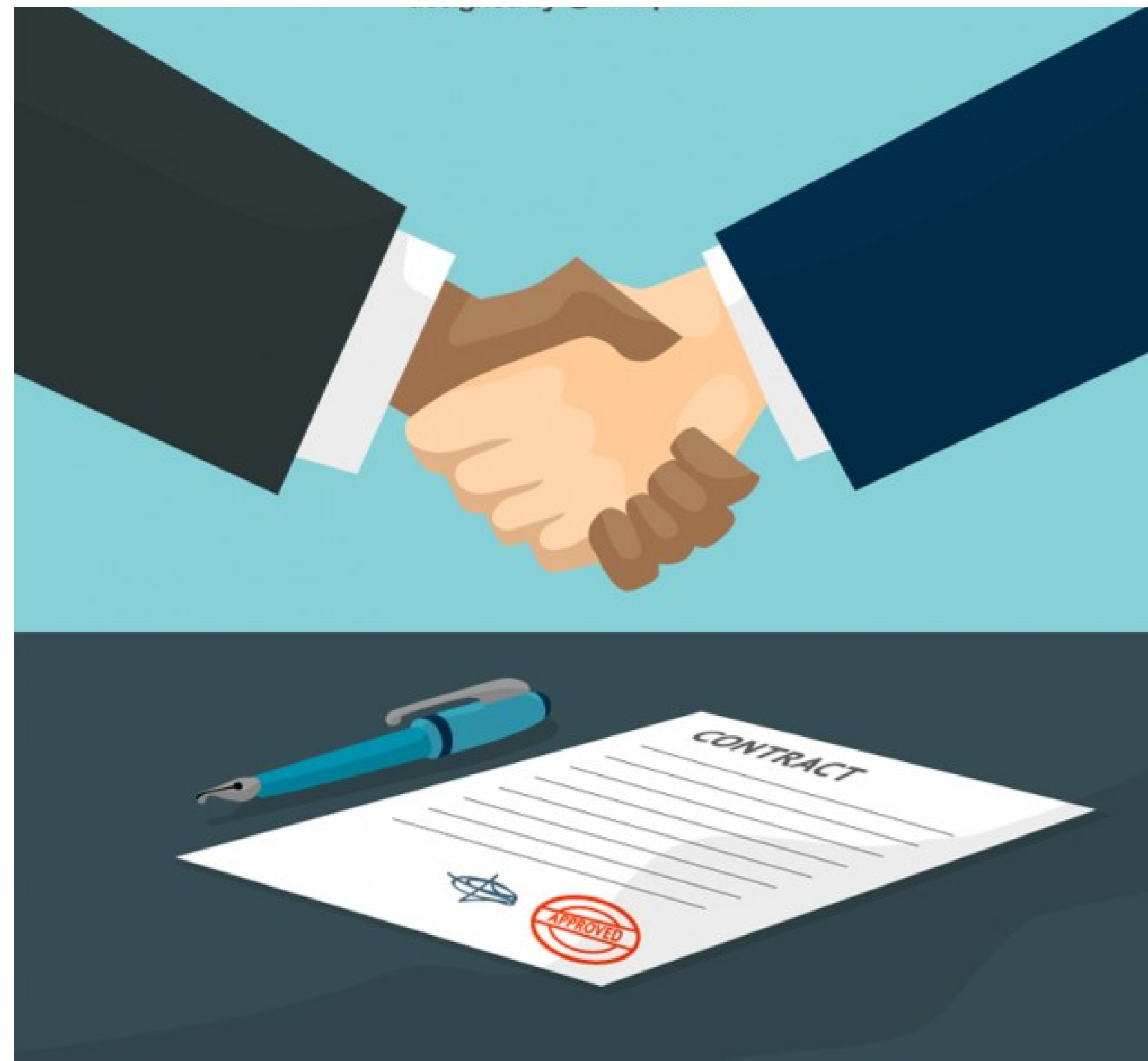




Alliance = “a **union** or association formed for mutual benefit, especially between countries or organizations.” - Google Dictionary



League = “a **collection** of people, **countries**, or groups that **combine** for a particular purpose, typically mutual protection or cooperation.” - Google Dictionary



A covenant in general is an agreement in which a union or league between at least two people are made for the benefit of each other.

What makes God's everlasting covenant revealed in the Bible have a deeper meaning?



1) God's covenant is an agreement which forms a union between God and us for our benefit.

2) God's covenant is “everlasting.” It is perpetual or eternal with no end.



3) God's covenant involves cutting flesh –
blood



“Covenant” in Hebrew comes from word “barah” [baw-raw] = to eat, consume – Strong's reference #H1262.

4) God's covenant involves the eating and drinking of what has been cut

Flesh had to be cut and blood had to be spilled in order to activate and ratify the everlasting covenant.



John 1:14

14 And the **Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) **full of grace and truth**.**



Jesus is 100% divine and became 100% human flesh. His cut flesh and spilled blood was payment for our sins and ratified and sealed the deal of the everlasting covenant.



The everlasting covenant reunifies us with heaven through the blood and flesh of Jesus and gives us everlasting life for those who believe in the covenant and are obedient to it.



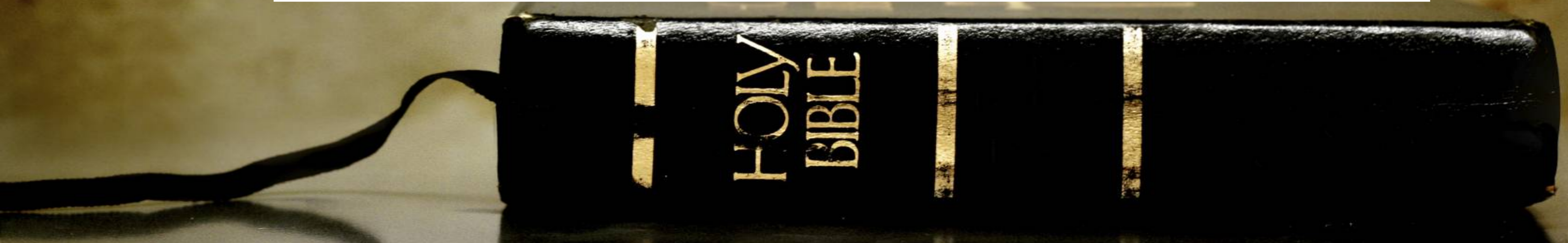
Jesus, the Word in the FLESH and the author of the everlasting covenant demonstrated to us how to live by the everlasting covenant.

1 Peter 2:21-25

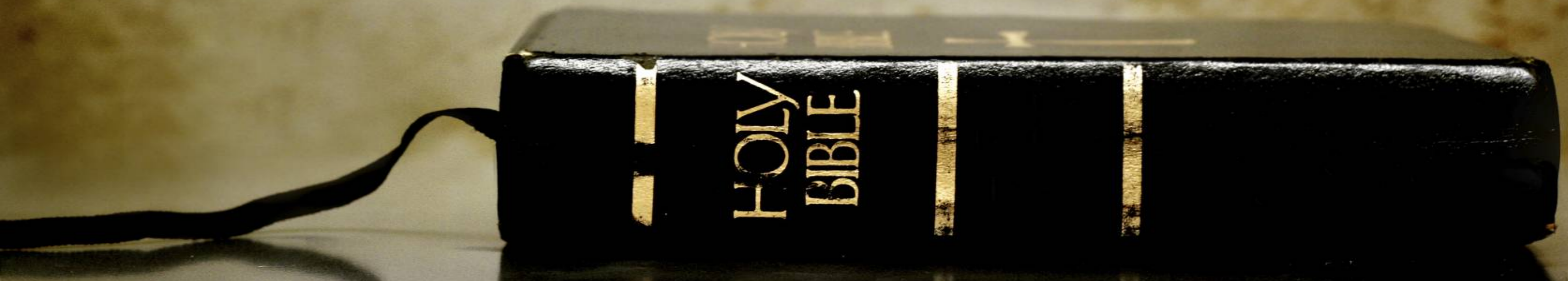

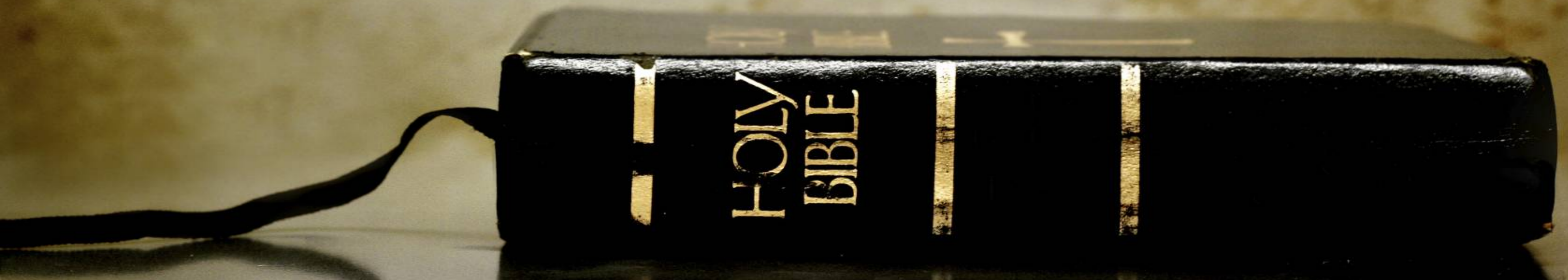

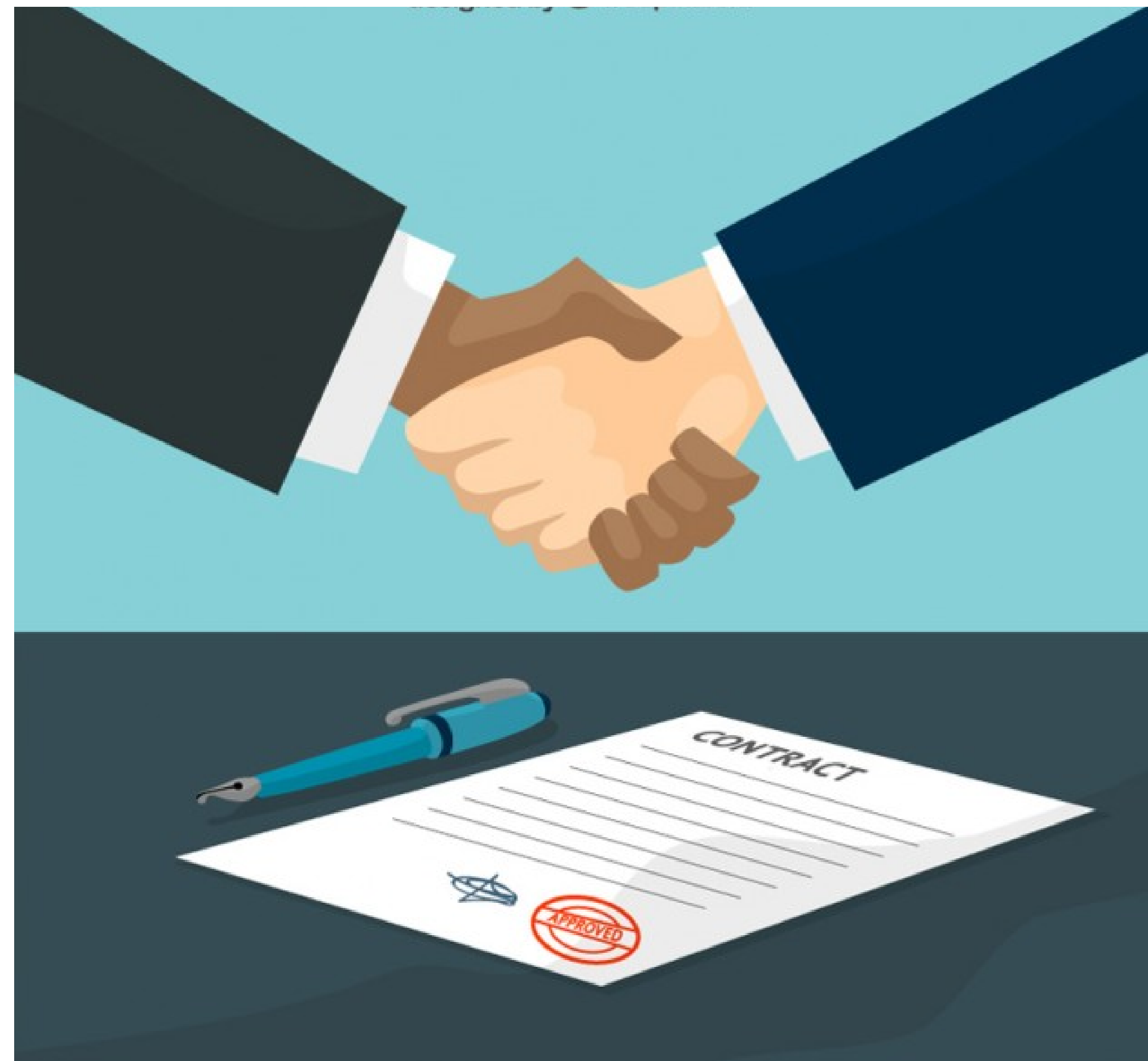


The Flesh represents the written WORD of GOD. The Word in the FLESH also left the Holy written Word of the everlasting covenant in black and white. The Word of God is the flesh of Christ that must be consumed everyday through prayer and study.



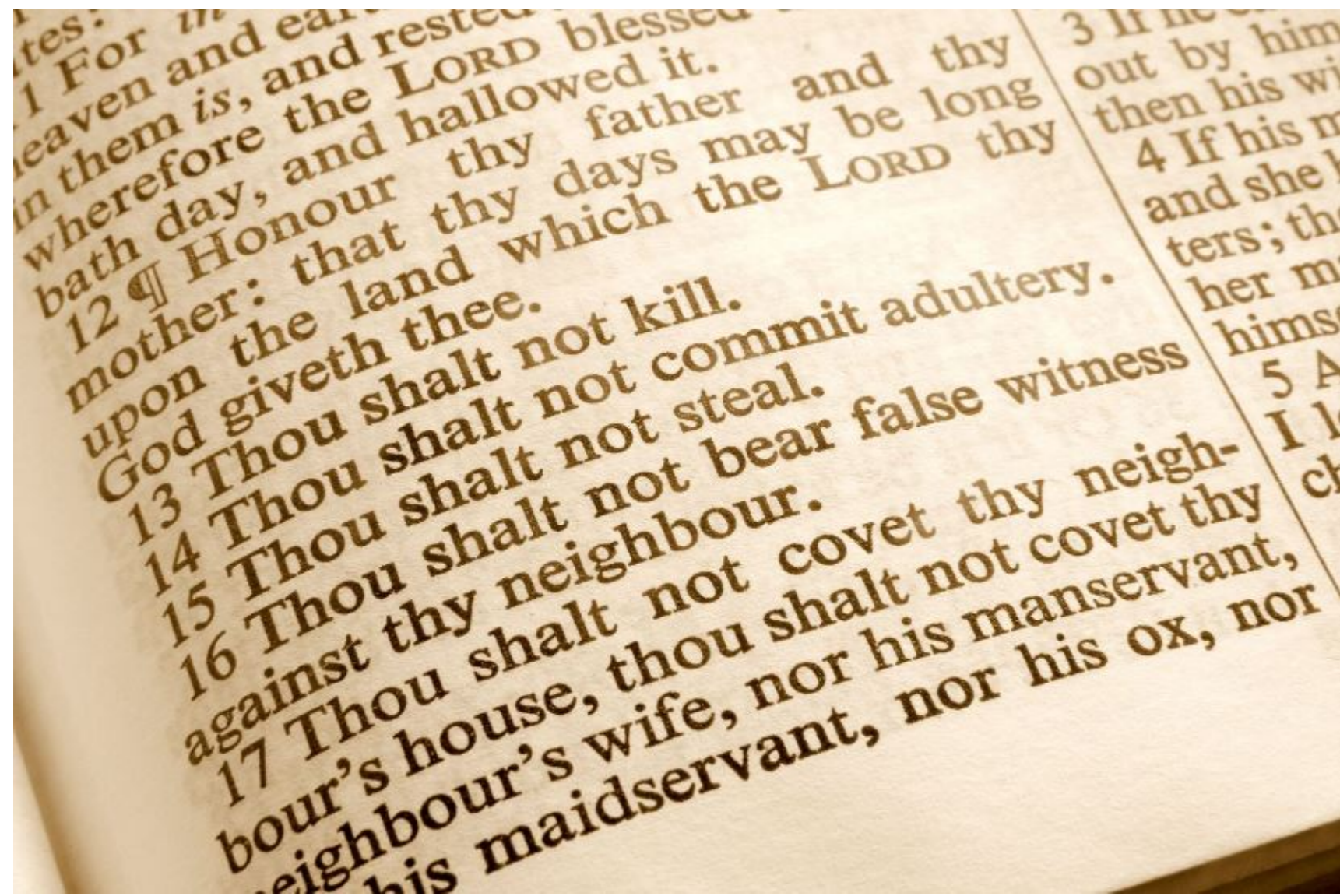

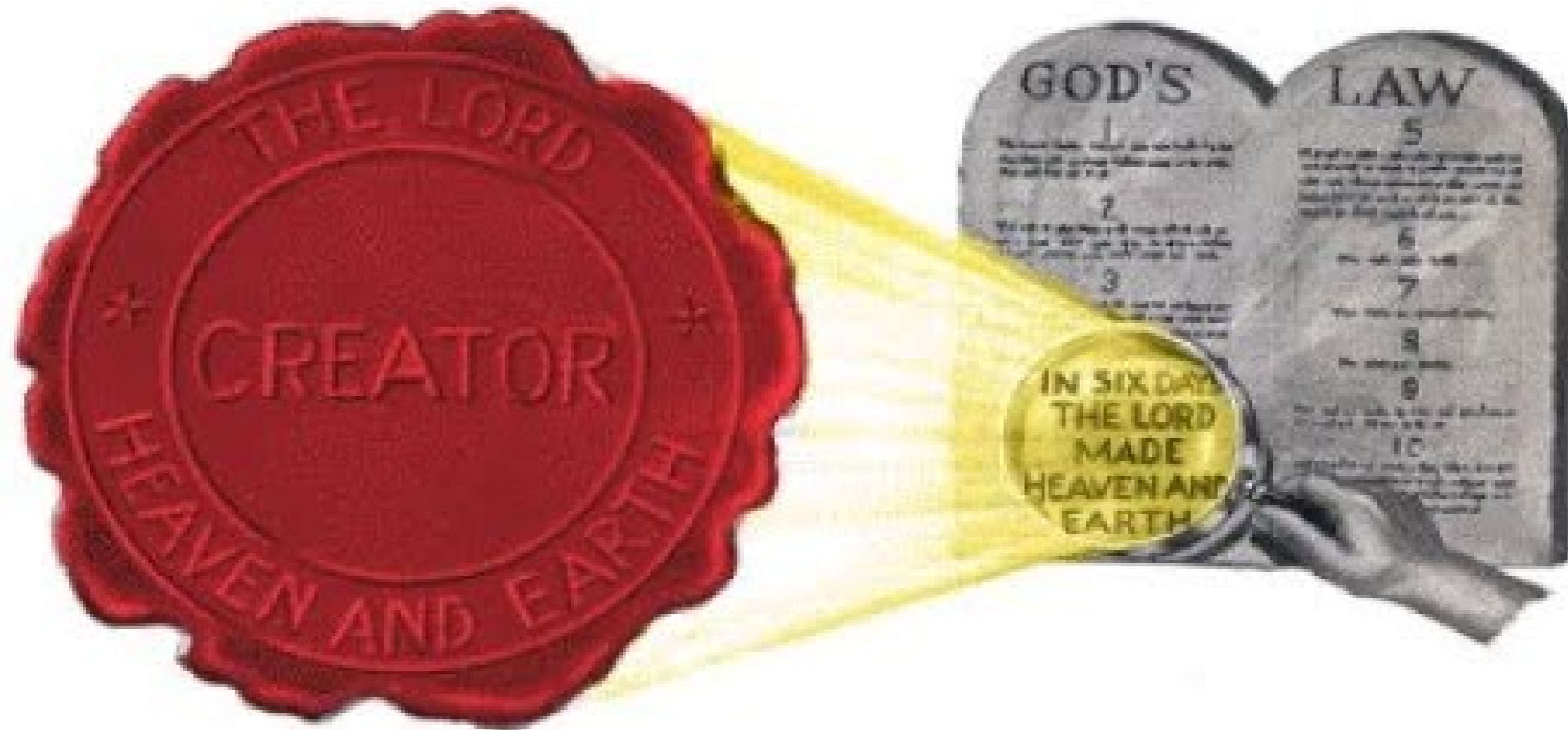
What is the official contract that sums up the everlasting covenant?

The Seal of the Living God

God's seal of the Ten Commandments, the official contract of the everlasting covenant, is the fourth commandment, the Seventh day Sabbath.

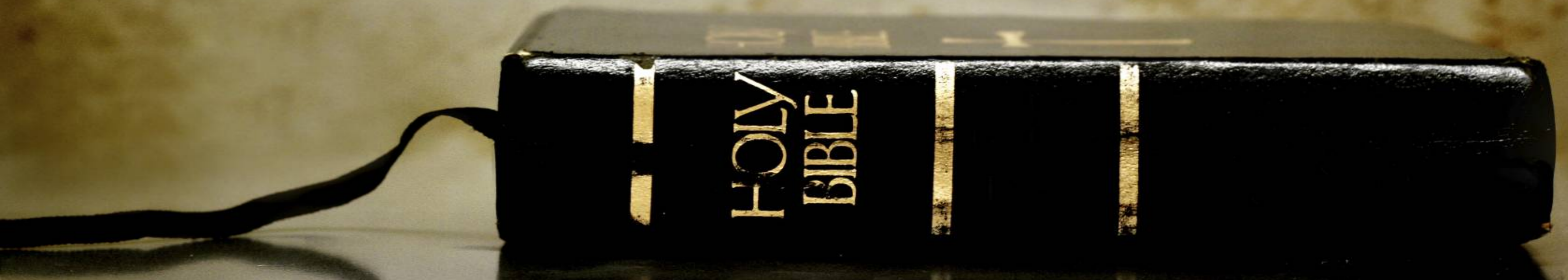


Seven is one of God's favorite numbers, but it is extremely important when it comes understanding the everlasting covenant.



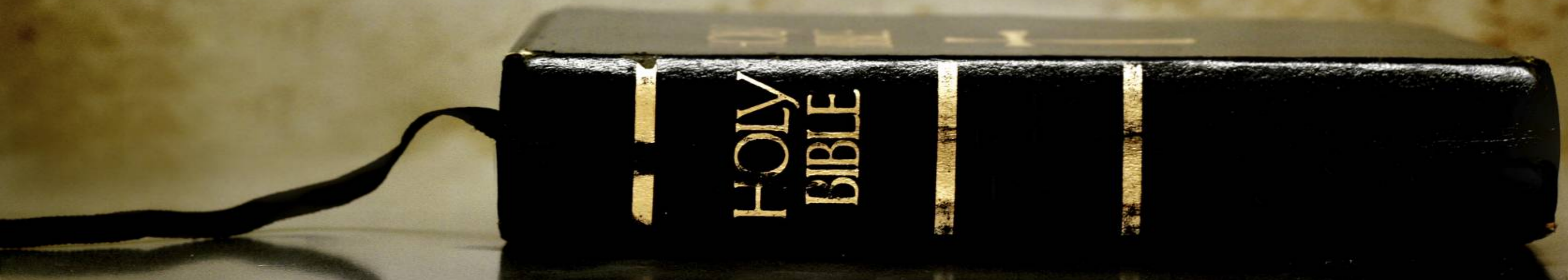
Seven is a number of completeness and promise. Seven is a sign or monument of God's everlasting covenant that Jesus swares unto himself to the world.

Daniel 12:6,7
Revelation 10:5, 6



Sware (Hebrew) shâba' [shaw-bah']

A primitive root; properly to be complete, but used only as a denominative from H7651; **to seven oneself, that is, swear** (as if by repeating a declaration seven times): - adjure, charge (by an oath, with an oath), **feed to the full** [by mistake for H7646], take **an oath**, X straitly, (cause to, make to) swear



Did you know that Jesus himself repeats this declaration of His second coming seven times in Revelation? (The words are in red)



(1) Revelation 2:25

25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come.

(2) Revelation 3:3

3 Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

(3) Revelation 3:11

11 Behold, **I come quickly**: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

(4) Revelation 16:15

15 Behold, **I come as a thief**. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

5) Revelation 22:7

7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

(6) Revelation 22:12

12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

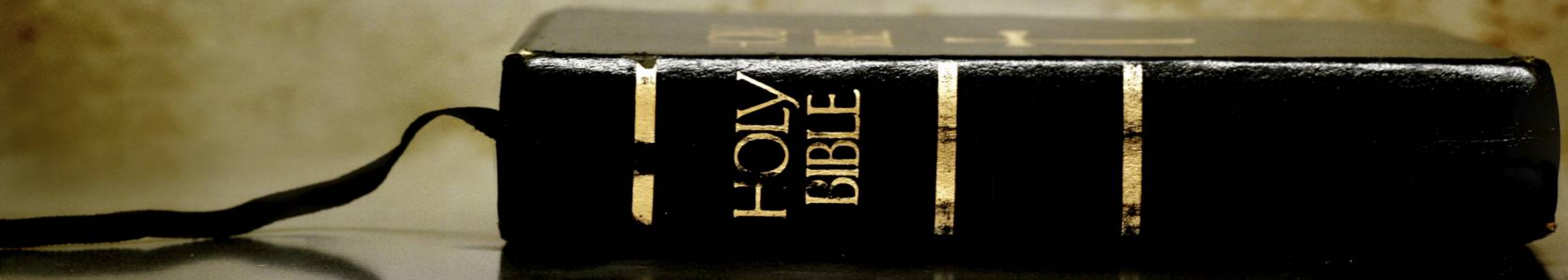
(7) Revelation 22:20

20 He which testifieth these things saith, **Surely I come quickly.** Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

Also Sware means – “Feed to the FULL”!

Matthew 5:6 (Jesus says)

6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.





Did you also know that Seventh-day Sabbath stands as a monument of God's oath of the everlasting covenant?

Oath = **shaba'** - H7650

Sabbath (Hebrew) = Shabbath [shab-bawth']
Intensive from H7673; **intermission**, that is,
(specifically) the Sabbath: - (+ every) Sabbath.

Ab (Hebrew) = Father / Abba (Greek) = Father

**The seventh day Sabbath is the Father's oath
to all the world of His everlasting covenant.**

Leviticus 24:8

8 Every sabbath he shall set it in order before the LORD continually, *being taken* from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.

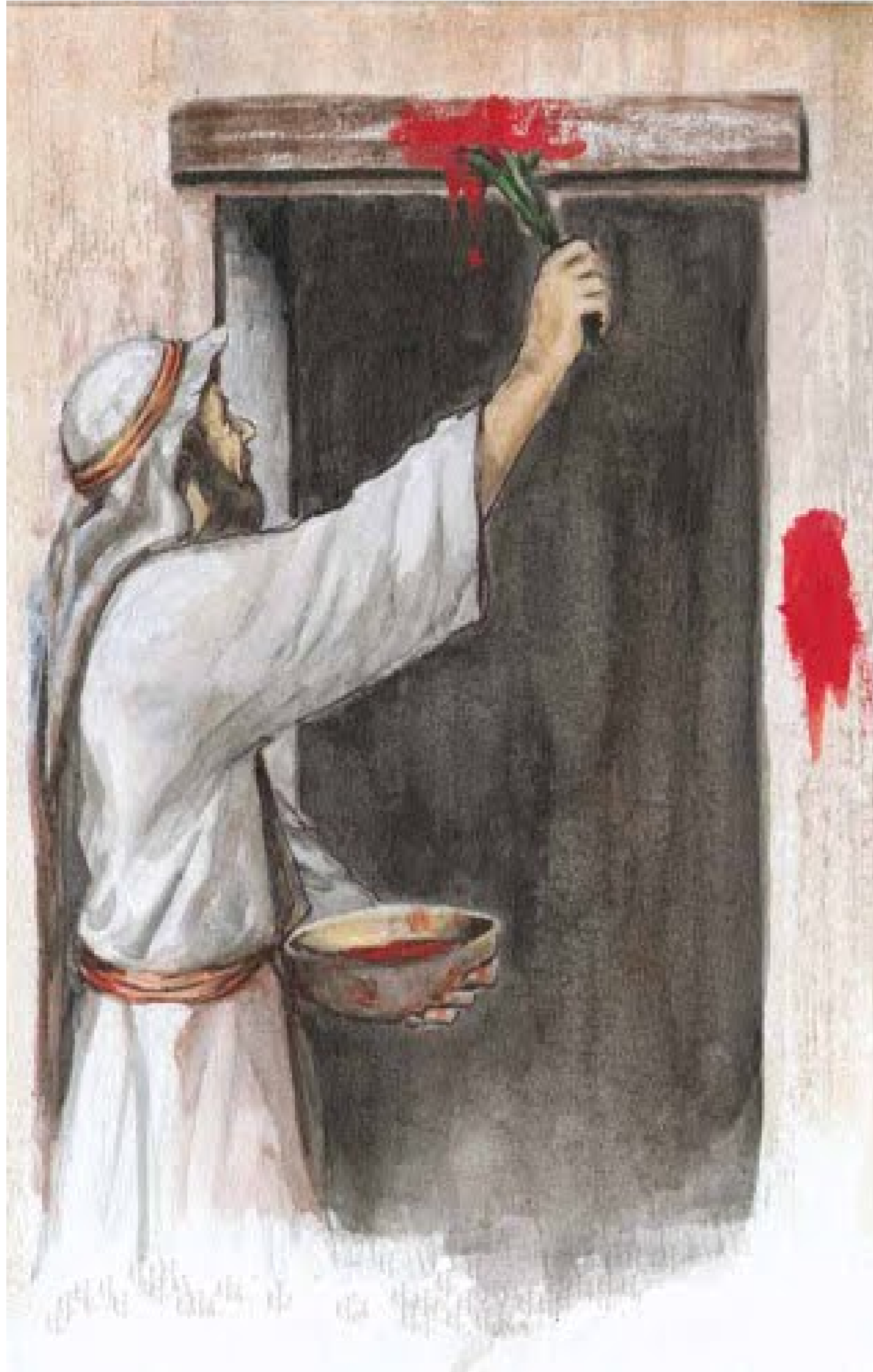

Passover stands as in commemoration of the Passover of Lamb, Jesus Christ and His everlasting covenant.



When is Passover?

Leviticus 23:5

In the **fourteenth *day* of the first month** at even is the LORD'S passover.



Passover is on the fourteen day of the first month, known as the month of Nisan on the Hebrew Calendar. (March/April according to the Gregorian calendar that most the world uses today)



Did you know that according to Exodus 12:41 and Galatians 3:16, 17 that on the exact same day, about 430 years before the first Passover, God made the covenant with Abraham in Genesis 17?

Summary - Passover (14th of Nisan) is the “selfsame day”:

- 1) Covenant made with Abraham (Genesis 17:1-7; Exodus 12:40 & 41; Galatians 3:16-18)**
- 2) The children of Israel left Egypt (Exodus 12:51)**
- 3) Sanctuary service began in the wilderness (Numbers 9:1-5, 15, 16)**
- 4) Israel entered into the Canaan land (Joshua 5:10-12)**
- 5) Jesus was crucified (Matthew 26:2)**

“Terrible were the calamities that fell upon Jerusalem when the siege was resumed by Titus. The city was invested at the time of the **Passover**, when millions of Jews were assembled within its walls.” - Ellen White, Great Controversy, p. 31



It was on Passover that the nations of this world officially **BROKEN** the true everlasting covenant of Jesus of Christ and made union with the beast, Papal Rome through the Paris Agreement.

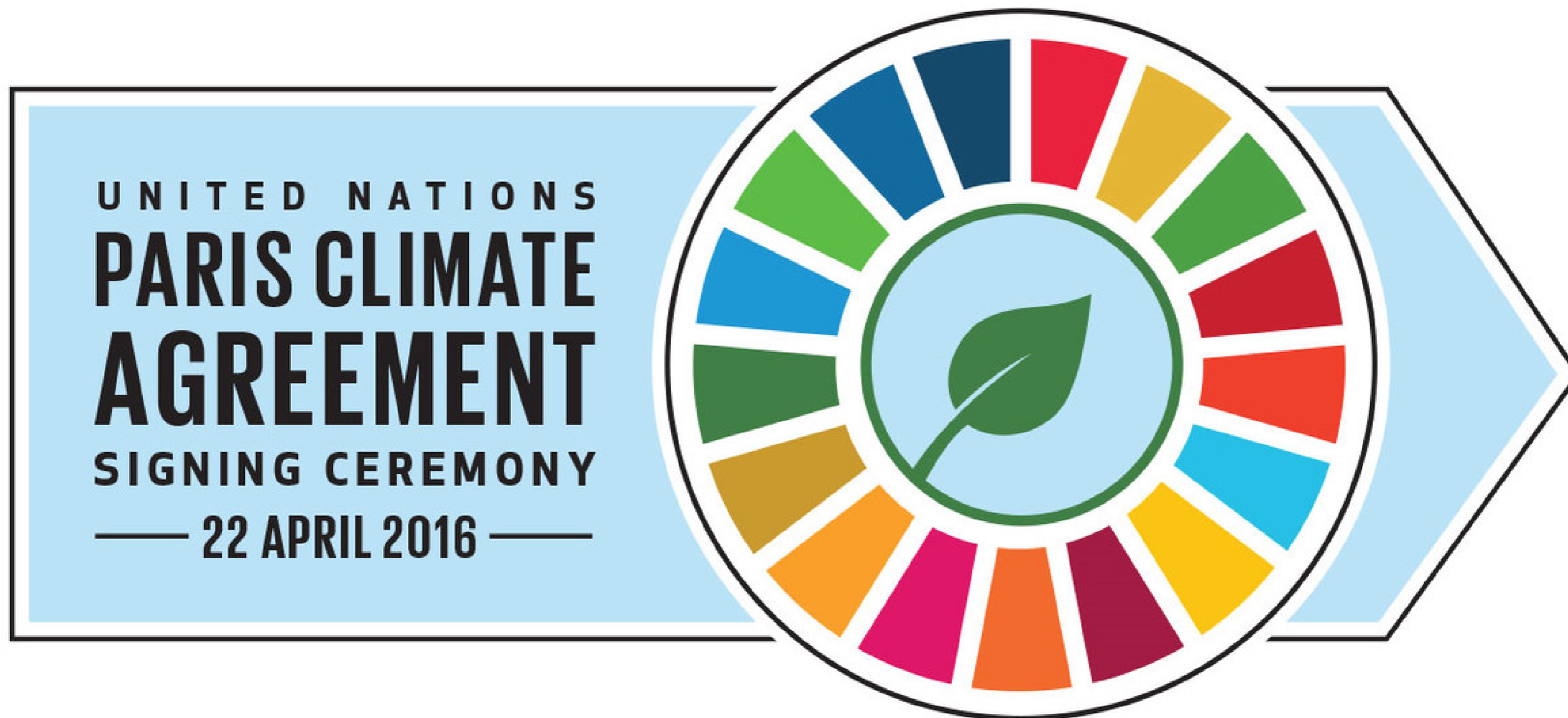

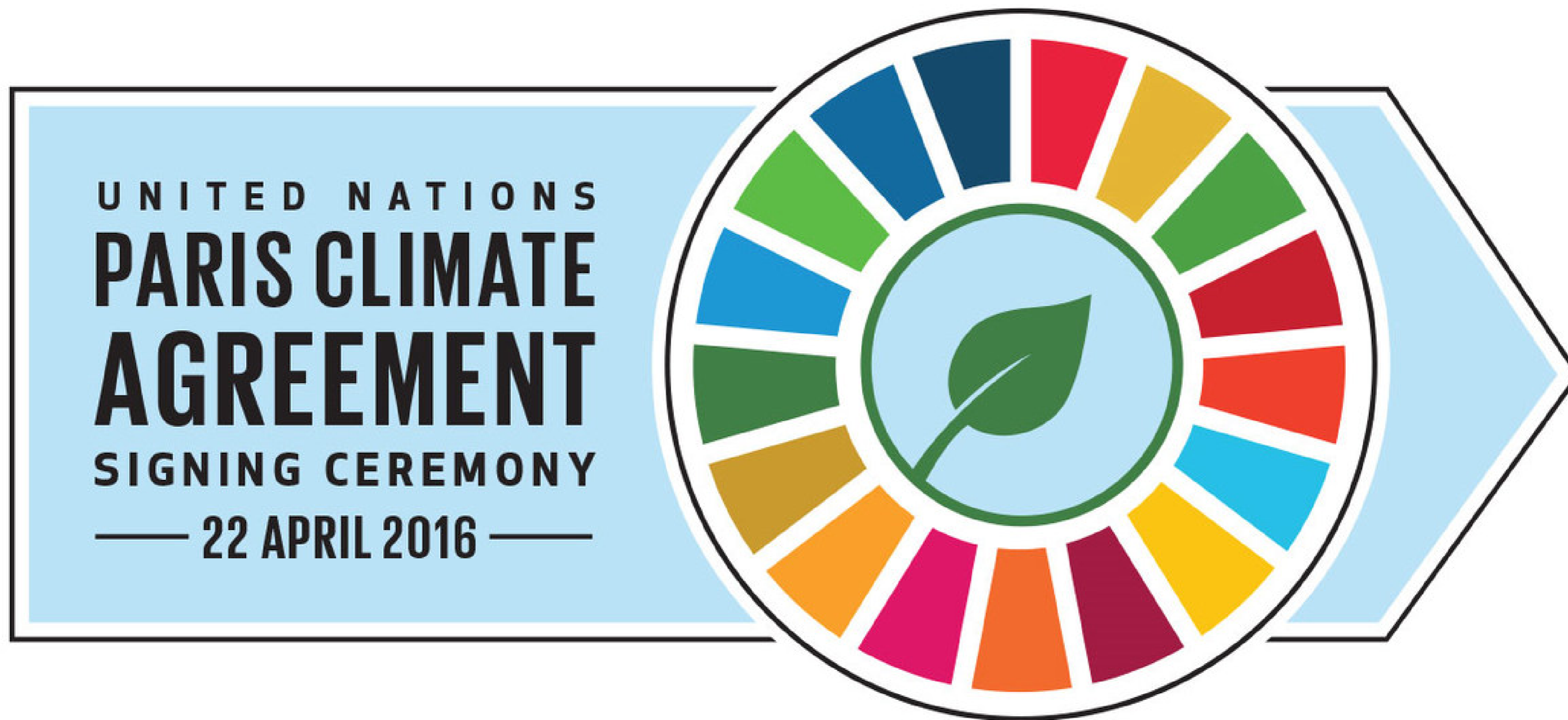


ENCYCLICAL LETTER





It was on **Passover, April 22, 2016**, Friday over 170 nations around the world officially signed the Paris Agreement at the UN during a signing ceremony to commemorate “Earth day.”



It was the exact same day, 1985 years ago, that the Passover Lamb, Jesus Christ, ratified the true covenant with His blood. The Paris Agreement led by the papacy, the abomination of desolation, was “covenanted”, officially agreed upon on Passover.



Former Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon told all the nations during the signing ceremony,

“Today we are signing a **new covenant** for the future.”
