What Must I do to be Saved?

KJV Bible Lesson Series: Lesson 1

How did the earth begin?

Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

Read also Isaiah 44:24; Colossians 1:16,17.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: God made the world and the things therein in six literal days, and on the seventh day He rested. (Read Genesis 2:1-3) After God made the earth, sun, moon, stars, the animals on land, the creatures in the water, and formed man and woman out of the dust of the ground by His infinite wisdom and power the Bible says, “and, behold, it was very good.” (Genesis 1:31) “And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed. And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.” Genesis 2:8,9. All was peace and happiness. Pain, suffering, and death did not exist.

So what caused the pain, suffering, and death we have in our world today?

Read Romans 5:12; Romans 6:23.

Write the Bible Answer:

How did sin enter the world?

Read Romans 5:19; Romans 5:12.

Write the Bible Answer:

“For as by one man’s disobedience many were made sinners,” and sin, with its

terrible results, came into the world.

When did this happen?

Read Genesis 2:16,17; Genesis 3:1-6.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: God commanded them not to eat the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. After Satan’s rebellion in Heaven this was the only place he could tempt them to disobey on earth. God gives everyone a choice of who they will serve. This tree was a test to see if they were going to stay loyal to God or if they would rebel. If Adam and Eve stayed away from the tree, they would have been safe from the temptation of Satan. But God made it clear that if they ate of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, they would surely die. Eve ventured toward the forbidden tree. Satan went against what God said, “thou shalt surely die”, and instead said, “Ye shall not surely die.” This was the great deception.

Sadly, they transgressed the command of God, and would face the consequences of their disobedience, and without a Savior have no hope. Sin separated us from God. (Read Isaiah 59:2)

Sin brought pain, suffering, and death upon the world, So what would God do to save us? What promise did God give to us?

Read Genesis 3:15; Genesis 22:18.

Write the Bible Answer:

God gave a promise of a Seed that was to come through the woman who was to crush the head of the serpent. That Seed was to save a people who would have enmity against sin. All nations of the earth were to be blessed by this Seed.

Who is this Seed?

Galatians 3:16 “Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He

saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.”

Write the Bible Answer:

In order to save us what would Christ have to do?

Read Matthew 1:21-23; John 1:1-3,14,36,45; Isaiah 53:5-7

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The Word is Jesus. He is clothed with all Divinity. All things where made by Him. “And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist.” Colossians 1:17. When our Creator came to save us He felt our pains and sorrows and our temptations, and was “touched with the feeling of our infirmities.... in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.” Hebrews 4:15.

What was the payment that had to be paid?

Read Romans 6:23.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The penalty of sin is death. Without a Redeemer we were doomed to everlasting death. In order to be saved the payment for sin, death, had to be paid. Our Savior had to die.

Did He pay the payment for sin?

1 Peter 3:18 “For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:”

Read also Philippians 2:5-8; 1 Peter 2:24; Ephesians 5:2; Hebrews 13:12.

Write the Bible Answer:

God came to dwell with man. He was made in the likeness of man and took upon Himself the form of a servant. He humbled Himself unto the death of the cross. He did all this that He might bring us, who went astray, back to God. He bare our sins that we should live unto righteousness. Jesus, out of His love, paid the penalty of our sins.

In our own power do we have righteousness?

Read Isaiah 64:6.

Write the Bible Answer:

Of ourselves we have no righteousness. Our righteousness is as filthy rags.

Through Christ can we have righteousness?

Read Philippians 3:8,9; Romans 3:22.

Write the Bible Answer:

Through Christ I can be “found in him, not having mine own righteousness,” “but the righteousness which is of God by faith.”

What is this righteousness compared to?

Read Isaiah 61:10; Revelation 19:8; Revelation 7:13,14.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Righteousness is synonymous with justified. Justified means; to render just or innocent, free. So when we are made righteous by Christ we are free from sin.

Lesson 1

If you are laden down in sin come to Jesus for He can make you free! Jesus is giving the invitation, “Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.” Matthew 11:28-30.

How must I come to Jesus? What must I do to be saved?

Read Revelation 22:17; Acts 16:30-31; Hebrews 11:6.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Some may think that before they come to Christ they must get themselves right. But it is impossible to get ourselves right by our power. For it is “...not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.” Ephesians 2:8,9. Come to Jesus as you are. Those that come to Jesus must believe in Him. You must believe that He is the only redeemer, (read Isaiah 43:11) that He has died and rose again to save you, and “that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”

Who gives us this desire?

Read Philippians 2:13.

Write the Bible Answer:

God will work in you to desire to leave the old life of sin, and give you the power to do that which pleases Him.

What must happen to our filthy garments of sin?

Read Romans 13:12-14; James 1:21-22; Ephesians 4:22-24; Ezekiel 18:31-32.

Write the Bible Answer:

Lesson 1

We must lay apart all unrighteousness and receive the words of the Bible which shows us the way of salvation. The old person of sin must die, and you must be born again and live a new life in Christ. Sin causes death and sin will not go to heaven, so God calls you to repent so you will not die.

If I am in sin what must I do?

Acts 3:19 “Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;”

Write the Bible Answer:

God is calling the world to repent of their sins and be converted, living a new life in Christ.

What is to be the prayer of the sinner?

Read Psalms 51:2,3, 7, 10.

Write the Bible Answer:

Knowing that you cannot cleanse yourself from sin, ask God to wash you and purge you from sin. Jesus can wash the stains of sin from your life and make you whiter than snow.

If we do this what does Jesus promise to do?

Read 1 John 1:9; Psalms 32:5.

Write the Bible Answer:

If you repent and confess your sins, Jesus Christ will forgive and cleanse you from all unrighteousness. Do you want to be changed by Christ and live a new life? Jesus wants you to be saved. Give your life to Him today. Ask Him to work in you to will and to do of his good pleasure. Come to Jesus now!
