I Will Come Again

KJV Bible Lesson Series: Lesson 3

The first coming of Jesus Christ as our Savior was prophesied in the Bible; from the place of His birth, to the time of His anointing and earthly ministry. Over 125 prophecies in the Old Testament were accurately fulfilled in the New Testament.

What was the purpose of the first coming of Christ?

Read all the following text: Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 1:21-23.

Write the Bible Answer:

Sin brought pain, suffering, and death upon the world, but out of God's love and mercy "Emmanuel" was to come; God was to dwell with us "made in the likeness of man", He was to pay the penalty for sin and offer to all the world the gift of salvation. (Read Philippians 2:7; 1 John 4:9,10; Isaiah 53:3) Of this the Bible says, He was "...wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed." Isaiah 53:5. Philippians 2:8 says, "And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross." "For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened [raised] by the Spirit:" 1 Peter 3:18. 1 John 3:5 says, "And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin." Christ has made abundant provision for our salvation!

What promises does Jesus give that He will come again?

Read all the following texts: John 14:1-3; Matthew 16:27; Revelation 22:20; Hebrews 9:28.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: This time He will not come as a "man of sorrows", "oppressed" and "afflicted", but "highly exalted" "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS", "...coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." Matthew 24:30-31. (Read Isaiah 53:3,7; Philippians 2:9; Revelation 19:16.)

Why is Jesus coming again?

Read Revelation 22:12.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Jesus is coming to give the righteous the payment for their service and obedience, but the wicked will also receive wages for their sins.

What will the righteous receive?

Read all the following text: John 3:36; Romans 2:7,8.

Write the Bible Answer:

The righteous will receive immortality and the gift of everlasting life that is promised to all who believe and give their lives to Jesus Christ.

What will happen to the righteous dead?

Read all the following text: 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17; 1 Corinthians 15:51-53; John 5:25,28, 29; Revelation 20:5,6.

Write the Bible Answer:

The voice of Jesus will pierce through the grave, no matter how deep, and then the righteous dead will be resurrected. The righteous that were once dead but now live, together with the righteous living will then receive immortality. This is called the first resurrection.

What will happen to death?

Read Isaiah 25:8,9.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: This is when the righteous will receive the promised gift of “everlasting life.” (John 3:16) It is also when Christ will receive His faithful to dwell with Him and we shall “ever be with the Lord”!

How will Jesus come? Will it be a secret?

Read all the following text: Acts 1:9-11; Revelation 1:7; Mark 13:26.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The coming of Christ will be a glorious event for His people. He will come in the clouds with power and great glory, and “every eye” of those living when He comes “shall see Him”, and the righteous will “meet the Lord in the air”. Jesus will not walk upon the earth at His second coming. This spectacular event will be no secret. There will not be a secret rapture, “For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.” Matthew 24:27.

Will Satan try to counterfeit the second coming of Jesus?

Read Matthew 24:23-26.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Jesus warns us in Matthew 24:24 that there will arise “false Christs, and false prophets” who will deceive the people by saying that Christ is in a desert or secret location. Jesus warns us and says “believe it not.”

What does the Bible say about the home of the redeemed?

After God has made a total end of sin, He will make all things new!

Read all the following text: Acts 3:20,21; Revelation 21:1.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: This will be the home of the redeemed. God will make a new sky and a new earth that will not be defiled with sin, misery, pain, and death.

Who will the redeemed will dwell with?

Read Revelation 21:2,3.

Write the Bible Answer:

The redeemed will dwell with God, and God will dwell with His people!

How does the Bible describe the “Holy City”?

Read Revelation 21:10,11; Revelation 21:18.

Write the Bible Answer:

The beauty of the Holy City far surpasses all the cities of the earth now. The Bible describes it as “like unto a stone most precious” and “clear as crystal”.

Can we have confidence that this will happen?

Read Revelation 21:4,5.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The Bible is not a fiction book, but was given to us by God to show us the way to life, and reveal to us the things He has in store for those that love and obey Him. The Bible says, “And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: ...They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. ...They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the LORD. Isaiah 65:21-23,25.

The new earth will forever be the habitation of God! There will be no more death, crying, sorrow, and pain, the former things will be passed away! The redeemed will forever dwell with their God! And God will dwell with them forevermore! “These words are true and faithful.”

The Bible says in Psalms 31:19, “Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!”

What will not be in the home of the redeemed?

Read all the following text: Revelation 21:27; Revelation 21:7,8.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: These things cannot be in the Holy Habitation because it is sin that cost

this earth so much pain, suffering, and death.

Jesus is coming soon! Who is Jesus coming for?

Read all the following text: Titus 3:7; 2 Peter 3:13,14; John 17:17.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Those who want to be with Christ when He comes must be justified (declared free from sin) by his grace and live a holy life by and through Jesus Christ.

How can we be justified?

Read all the following text: Romans 3:24; Romans 5:8-10.

Write the Bible Answer:

We are "...justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus" by faith. The gift of grace is offered to you freely! Jesus has already made the payment for sins so that we can be cleansed from sin.

When we come to Christ, "Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity...", (Titus 2:14) and repent and confess our sins, what will Christ do?

Read 1 John 1:9.

Write the Bible Answer:

Christ by His blood will forgive us and cleanse us from sin, and it will be declared that we are righteous, washed in the blood of the Lamb.

How can you live a holy life, or in other words, be sanctified?

Read all the following text: Ephesians 5:25,26; John 17:17.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Sanctification is not something you do for just one day, it is a daily

experience.

What does it mean to be sanctified by truth?

Read all the following text: 2 Timothy 3:16,17; James 1:22.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The word of God shows us the way of righteousness. This is our only instruction map that will lead us to Heaven. We must be "...doers of the word, and not hearers only".

Are those who will dwell in the "Holy City" still into the things of the world?

Read all the following text: 1 John 5:4; 2 Timothy 2:19; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Titus 2:11-14; 1 Peter 1:13-15; Revelation 21:7; 1 John 2:15,16.

Write the Bible Answer:

Only those who have overcome the things of the world through Jesus Christ will dwell in the Holy City. They have let go of the things that please the lust of the flesh, the videos, TV programs, movies, the games that promote fornication, covetousness, the pride of life, drunkenness, stealing, disobedience to God, etc..., which will not inherit the kingdom of God. If you are still in these things, you have hope to overcome through Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior who is coming to take those who have overcome home to dwell with Him forevermore where all is peace, joy, and happiness!

God offers the gift of salvation to everyone freely! Jesus is earnestly calling you to come to Him to be saved. Now is the time! At Jesus second coming, there will be no second chance.

Now is Jesus pleading! He is saying, "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest", "Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else." Matthew 11:28-30; Isaiah 45:22. "...There is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." Acts 4:12.

Friend, you have a sin pardoning Savior who can save you from all your sins. He wants you to be saved. He died and rose again to save you. Will you accept the gift of salvation He has offered you out of His grace, or will you reject it and pay the penalty for your sin which is death everlasting? Jesus is coming again and if you want to be ready when He comes, let Him come into your heart today.
