Write the Bible Answer:

We must lay apart all unrighteousness and receive the words of Bible which shows us the way of salvation. The old person of sin must die, and you must be burn again and live a new life in Christ. Sin causes death and sin will not go to heaven, so God calls you to repent so you will not die.

What are some practicable examples the Bible gives us of sin?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-10.

Write the Bible Answer:

Read 1 Corinthians 6:11.

Write the Bible Answer:

If I am in sin what must I do? And what is the prayer of the sinner to be?

Read Acts 3:19; Psalms 51:2-3, 7, 10.

Write the Bible Answer:

If we do this what does Jesus promise to do?

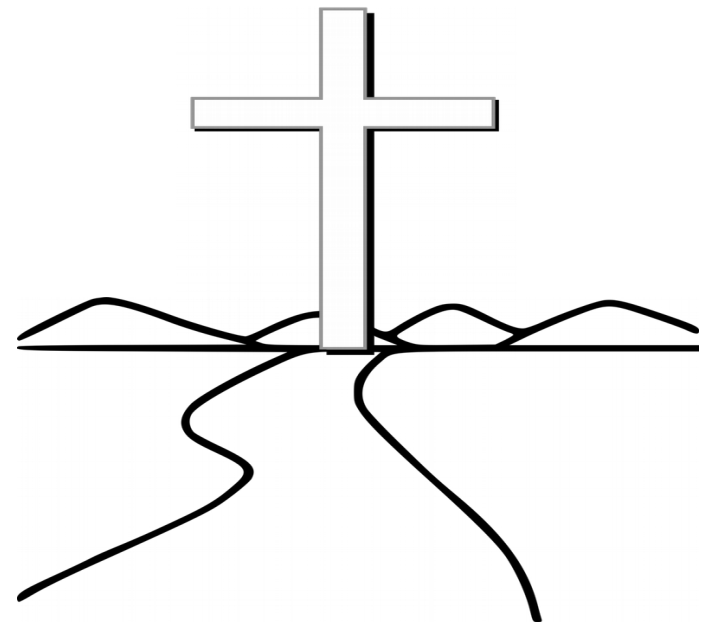
Read 1 John 1:9; Psalms 32:5.

Salvation in the Sanctuary Lesson 2

The sanctuary that God commanded the children of Israel to build in the wilderness was built to teach us about the way of salvation. There was only one door to enter the sanctuary. This door was the way to life. But, we know that the earthly sanctuary just taught them of the things of salvation, but it could not save them. So this door has a spiritual lesson for us.

Who is the one door to salvation?

Read John 10:7 .

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: The sheep represent us. If you enter the through the Door, Jesus, you will be saved.

The sheep have a shepherd. The shepherd also is Jesus.

Read John 10:14.

As the Good Shepherd Jesus is the guide of his sheep, He takes care of them and protects them. As the Door of the sheep Jesus is the only way to salvation. There is only one way to salvation. You can not go the heaven in sin. You cannot be saved by your own power, neither is there any other that can save you. The only Door to salvation is Jesus Christ.

What does Jesus say about this?

Read John 14:6.

Write the Bible Answer:

Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. So if you want to know the way to salvation come to Jesus. If you want to know the truth, study His word, the Bible, and Jesus will teach you. If you want everlasting life come to the One that has the gift of everlasting life, and accept it.

What did Jesus do to save the us, the sheep?

Read John 10:11,15-18; Luke 15:4-7.

Write the Bible Answer:

Jesus gave His life (died) then took it again (resurrected) to save the sheep. He went on a search for the sheep that were not saved. Jesus left His throne in heaven to save you.

What more does the Bible say about this?

Read 1 Peter 3:18; 1 Peter 2:24.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: God came to dwell with man made in the likeness of man took upon Himself the form of a servant, humbled himself and became unto the death of the cross. He did all this that he might bring us, who went astray, back to God. He bare our sins that we should live unto righteousness. Jesus out of His love He paid the penalty of our sins.

So what must I do to be saved?

Read Matthew 11:28-30.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Jesus calls us to come, and learn of Him, give your life to Him, and He promises to give you rest.

But how can you came to Him if you do not believe in Him?

Read Hebrews 11:6; Acts 16:30-31.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: We must believe in Him and come to him and he will save us.

How are we to come to Christ?

Some may think that before they come to Christ they must get themselves right. But it is impossible to get ourselves right by our own power.

Ephesians 2:8-9 “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

Come to Jesus as you are. But you must first believe in Jesus. You must believe that He is the only redeemer, (read Isaiah 43:11) that He has died and rose again to save you, and “*that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”

Who gives us this desire?

Read Philippians 2:13.

Write the Bible Answer:
