Did you know that the Bible gives us a detailed account of years beginning with Creation? With this information we can calculate the real age of the earth.

Obviously, God wants us to know where we are in time! God declares in Isaiah 46:9,10, "Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:"

# AGE OF THE EARTH

## Creation

Genesis 1:1,27 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. 27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them."

0

## Adam

Genesis 5:3 "And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:"

$$0+130= 130$$

## Seth

Genesis 5:6 "And Seth lived an hundred and five years, and begat Enos:"

$$130+105= 235$$

## Enos

Genesis 5:9 "And Enos lived ninety years, and begat Cainan:"

$$235+90= 325$$

## Cainan

Genesis 5:12 "And Cainan lived seventy years, and begat Mahalaleel:"

$$325+70= 395$$

## Mahalaleel

Genesis 5:15 "And Mahalaleel lived sixty and five years, and begat Jared:"

$$395+65= 460$$

## Jared

Genesis 5:18 "And Jared lived an hundred sixty and two years, and he begat Enoch:"

$$460+162= 622$$

## Enoch

Genesis 5:21 "And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah:"

$$622+65= 687$$

## Methuselah

Genesis 5:25 "And Methuselah lived an hundred eighty and seven years, and begat Lamech:"

$$687+187= 874$$

## Lamech

Genesis 5:28,29 "And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son: 29 And he called his name Noah..."

$$874+182= 1056$$

## Noah

Genesis 7:6 "And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth."

$$1056+600= 1656$$

## After the Flood

Genesis 11:10 "These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood:"

$$1656+2= 1658$$

Arphaxad

Genesis 11:12 "And Arphaxad lived five and thirty years, and begat Salah:"

$$1658+35= 1693$$

Salah

Genesis 11:14 "And Salah lived thirty years, and begat Eber:"

$$1693+30= 1723$$

Eber

Genesis 11:16 "And Eber lived four and thirty years, and begat Peleg:"

$$1723+34= 1757$$

Peleg

Genesis 11:18 "And Peleg lived thirty years, and begat Reu:"

$$1757+30= 1787$$

Reu

Genesis 11:20 "And Reu lived two and thirty years, and begat Serug:"

$$1787+32= 1819$$

Serug

Genesis 11:22 "And Serug lived thirty years, and begat Nahor:"

$$1819+30= 1849$$

Nahor

Genesis 11:24 "And Nahor lived nine and twenty years, and begat Terah:"

$$1849+29= 1878$$

Terah

Genesis 11:32;12:1,4 "And the days of Terah were two hundred and five years: and Terah died in Haran. 1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: 4 So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran."

$$1878+205= 2083$$

Abram Born

Since Abram was 75 years old when Terah died at age 205, what year was Abram born?

$$2083-75= 2008$$

Everlasting Covenant

Genesis 17:1,7 "And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. 7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee."

Read Leviticus 26:42,45

$$2008+99= 2107$$

Exodus 31:16 "Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual [everlasting] covenant."

### Exodus out of Egypt

Galatians 3:17 "And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect."

Exodus 12:40,41 "Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, who dwelt in Egypt, was four hundred and thirty years. 41 And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day it came to pass, that all the hosts of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt."

*Note: The law was proclaimed the same year they left Egypt Read Exodus chapter 19 & 20.*

$$2107 + 430 = 2537$$

### 4th Year of Solomon

1 Kings 6:1 "And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the **fourth year of Solomon's reign** over Israel, in the month Zif, which is the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD."

$$2537 + 480 = 3017$$

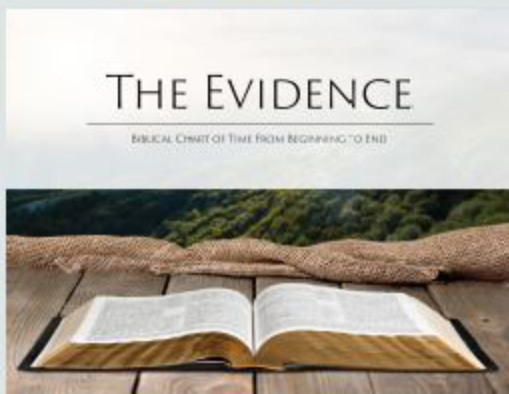
The 4th year of King Solomon's reign was a major event in history because it was when he began to build the temple with help from Hiram, king of Tyre. This event happened when the age of the earth was 3017 years old which corresponds with 964 BC. The Bible continues to keep an account of the years during the reign of the kings of Israel and Judah that confirm 964 BC is the corresponding date. For example, 2 Kings 17:6 records that Israel was taken into captivity by Assyria in the 9th year of King Hoshea; counting the years given in the Bible, the age of the earth was 3259 years to Israel's captivity which was in 722 BC.

Continue to count the corresponding years.

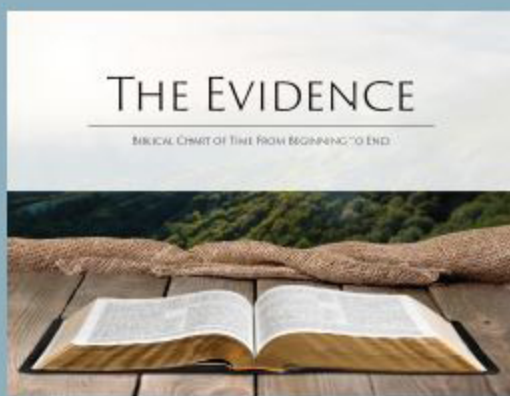
