3 Types of Bone Cells

1. OSTEOCLASTS


2. OSTEOBLASTS

3. OSTEOCYTES

- OSTEOCLASTS are large cells that dissolve the bone. They come from the bone marrow and are related to white blood cells. They are formed from two or more cells that fuse together, so the osteoclasts usually have more than one nucleus. They are found on the surface of the bone mineral next to the dissolving bone.
- OSTEOBLASTS are the cells that form new bone. They also come from the bone marrow and are related to structural cells. They have only one nucleus. Osteoblasts work in teams to build bone. They produce new bone called "osteoid" which is made of bone collagen and other protein. Then they control calcium and mineral deposition. They are found on the surface of the new bone.

When the team of osteoblasts has finished filling in a cavity, the cells become flat and look like pancakes. They line the surface of the bone. These old osteoblasts are also called LINING CELLS. They regulate passage of calcium into and out of the bone, and they respond to hormones by making special proteins that activate the osteoclasts.

• OSTEOCYTES are cells inside the bone. They also come from osteoblasts. Some of the osteoblasts turn into osteocytes while the new bone is being formed, and the osteocytes then get surrounded by new bone. They are not isolated, however, because they send out long branches that connect to the other osteocytes. These cells can sense pressures or cracks in the bone and help to direct where osteoclasts will dissolve the bone.



Purpose of remodeling:

Regulate calcium homeostasis, repair micro-damaged bones (from everyday stress) but also to shape and sculpture the skeleton during growth.

Repair

Repeated stress, such as weight-bearing exercise or bone healing, results in the bone thickening at the points of maximum stress (Wolff's law).

How the bone remodels and repairs itself is WOW – all this is happening in our bodies everyday. Again, we are fearfully and wonderfully made; To God be the glory!

True vs. False Sanctification

Today there are many people in modern churches who do not understand the difference between true vs. false sanctification. Remember everything that is genuine that comes from God, **Satan has a counterfeit to keep people in the state of rebellion against God.** This study is a Bible present truth for the faithful people of God.

What is the contrast between true vs. false sanctification?

True Sanctification (Summary)

2 Thessalonians 2:13

13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to **salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:**

Salvation through 1) sanctification & 2) belief of the truth

Sanctification

- Purification
- The state of purity
- Holiness

<u>Sanctify</u>

- Be HOLY
- Be SEPARATE

God's calls us to be sanctified, holy, pure, and separate from the world and Babylon

Leviticus 11:44-45

44 For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10

9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

1 Peter 2:9

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

1 Peter 1:13-16

13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14 As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

Conversation (Greek) = behavior

Come OUT of Babylon

Babylonian = confusion by mixing truth and lies to conceal its deception and destruction.

Revelation 18:4

4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Isaiah 52:11

11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.

2 Corinthians 6:17

17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

True sanctification is the process of being holy - totally separate from worldliness.

We must not affiliate ourselves with those in rebellion. When Korah rebelled against the leadership of Moses. God called his people to not support the rebellion and turn from it.

Numbers 16:24-26

24 Speak unto the congregation, saying, Get you up from about the tabernacle of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram.

25 And Moses rose up and went unto Dathan and Abiram; and the elders of Israel followed him.

26 And he spake unto the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins.

How are we sanctified?

Psalms 119:9

9 BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.

John 17:17

17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

1 Peter 1:22

22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1 John 1:7

7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

What is False Sanctification?

- It is a feeling of holiness but in reality it is corruption
- False state of purity
- unHoliness

2 Timothy 3:5

5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Titus 1:16

16 They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

Isaiah 29:13

13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:

Mark 7:9

9 And he said unto them, Full well **ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.**

False Sanctification also trusts SELF and human reasoning that conflicts and lacks faith in the Word of God.

What does God say about trusting in yourself?

Jeremiah 17:9

9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

False Sanctification is trying to make what is corruptible (garbage) holy!

Examples: The modern churches corrupt Gospel/Holy with R& B, Hip Hop, Dance, Entertainment and/or Rock.

False Sanctification/Worldliness is acceptable

False Sanctification = Defeat

True Sanctification is TOTAL TRANSFORMATION = Separation from SIN

2 Corinthians 5:17

17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

"True sanctification is not merely a theory, an emotion, or a form of words, but a living, active principle, entering into the every-day life. It requires that our habits of eating, drinking, and dressing be such as to secure the preservation of physical, mental, and moral health, that we may present to the Lord our bodies, not an offering corrupted by wrong habits, but a "living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God."--R. and H., 1881, No. 4. {Healthful Living 42.3}
